

Natomas Joint Vision Final Workshops for the Broad Visioning Process



The **Natomas Joint Vision** (NJV) is a collaborative planning effort between the City and County of Sacramento to develop a vision which balances future urban growth with the permanent preservation of open space in the unincorporated portion of the Natomas Basin within Sacramento County.

The **Broad Visioning Process** is a series of public workshops that will obtain broad public input in the development of an overall vision for the area. The series will conclude with workshops before the City and County Planning Commissions, the City Council, and the County Board of Supervisors.

The **Broad Visioning Process** will lead to the creation of:

- A set of fundamental principles to address the issues and guide subsequent planning efforts
- Conceptual land use diagrams for urban development and open space
- A project description with sufficient detail to proceed with subsequent planning phases

The City and County of Sacramento invite you to participate in the conclusion of the **Broad Visioning Process**.
