What is the Relationship to the General Plan?

► The Housing Element is part of the General Plan 2005-2030.

► The Housing Element has strategies, policies and programs related to housing. Updated every 8 years.





Special Needs Groups

- Seniors
- Persons with disabilities
- Homeless persons
- Large families
- Female heads of households
- Farm workers
- Extremely low-income households





Special Needs Groups

Seniors, Age 65 or Over

- Data:
 - Senior population growing faster than general population.
 - 76% are homeowners.
- Housing Issues:
 - Repair and maintenance of owned dwelling units.
 - Finding units that can accommodate their needs.





Special Needs Groups

Persons With Disabilities

- Data:
 - 13% of County population.
- Housing issues:
 - Finding housing that is affordable and accessible with supportive services close by.
 - Needed modification and accommodation of homes.



Special Needs GroupsHomeless Persons

Data:

- On January 27, 2011, 2,358 homeless individuals were counted.
 - 67% had one form of a disability.
 - 41% had alcohol or drug disabilities.
 - 26% had a mental health disability.
 - 13% were veterans.

Housing issues:

- Need of temporary or emergency shelter.
- Finding affordable housing.





Special Needs Groups Extremely Low-Income

- Data
 - 11.3% of County households.
- Housing issues:
 - Spending over 30% of income on housing.
 - Living in overcrowded conditions.
 - Living in substandard living conditions.





Past Achievements Housing for Seniors (2008-2012)

- Varenna Apartments 152 unit senior apartment complex.
- Continued provision of financial assistance for home repair and upkeep (385 homes during 2008-2011).





Past Achievements Housing for the Persons with Disabilities (2008-2012)

- Shelter Plus Care Program 3,350 individuals were served during 2008-2011.
- Brochure was prepared on universal design – distributed at County downtown public counters.
- The County continued to require accessible pedestrian facilities in new neighborhoods.





Past Achievements Assistance for Homeless Persons (2008-2012)

► Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Program – 1,418 homeless households were assessed and 581 households were housed.

Winter Shelter Program – A total of 1,600 individuals were served during 2008-2009, 2009-2010, and 2010-2011.





Past Achievements Increase Housing Supply for ELI Households (2008-2012)

- 2 projects for ELI households were constructed. Total of 70 units.
 - Vineyard Point
 - Arbor Creek Seniors
- Continuance of the voucher program 2010, SHRA maintained over 99% lease up of available vouchers.
